<i>Trinity</i>	I,J	The Illustrated Acts of the Apostles for Children (Kieffer, Jean-Francois) The adventures of the apostles, as recorded by Saint Luke in the New Testament, are told for young readers. The text begins with Pentecost, when the followers of Jesus are transformed by the gifts of the Holy Spirit into heroic witnesses of the Resurrection of Christ. The experiences of the early Church; the works of mercy, the miraculous healings, and the amazing conversions come to life.
	I,J	Spirit and Community: Spirit Alive in Community and A Child's View of Community (DVD) The first of these two programs profiles a real parish, looking at the ways the Holy Spirit is visibly active in the lives of Christians when they celebrate, worship, learn and serve together as members of the Body of Christ. Shares Jesus' invitation to "come and see" how the Spirit empowers us in community. The second program describes how a child can see the Spirit of Jesus Christ at work in the Church, depicting various images of what it means to "be Church."
	I,J	Catholic Connections: The Holy Spirit and the Church (St. Mary's Press) The Holy Spirit is the creative breath of God that gives birth to and sustains the life and mission of Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit and the Church Catechist's Helps young adolescents recognize that it is the power of the Holy Spirit that has united God's people in love.
	J,S	Teen Discipleship (DVD) Captures for Catholic youth how their baptismal commitment comes alive in service to others and looks at the work of the Holy Spirit in their lives.
	S	Trinity 101: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Papandrea, James Leonard) Offers readers a basic approach to the Trinity as history portrays it, as a doctrinal concept, and how it is revealed in the Scripture. This is highly useful to those seeking a starting point of Catholic theological study of the Trinity, from high school age onwards; and also to educated Catholic adults who are drawn to this topic.
	S,A	The One Thing is Three: How the Most Holy Trinity Explains Everything (Gaitley, Michael E.) With humor and ease, Fr. Gaitley deftly unlocks the 'one thing,' the key to the Church's wisdom, and the greatest mystery of the Catholic faith: the Most Holy Trinity. Far from being an academic read, The 'One Thing' Is Three makes deep theology accessible to everyday Catholics. What's more, it makes even what's familiar or forgotten new, exciting, and relevant.
	S,A	Holy Spirit 101: Present Among Us (Gresham, John Leroy) Offers readers a basic approach to coming to know this complex part of the trinity. Author John Gresham, dissects the difficult concept of the Holy Spirit, its place in history and scripture, as well as its connection to us today. In Holy Spirit 101, you will find examples, tools, and review questions perfect for group or individual study that will deepen the understanding of your faith.
	S,A	The Wild Goose: Discovering a Deeper Relationship with the Holy Spirit (DVD, 4PM Media, Franciscan Friars TOR) If you allow him, the Wild Goose will lead you on an adventure greater than you can imagine. The Spirit will lead you to a place of mercy, healing, peace, and presence. The Holy Spirit has been given to us not as a possession to be tamed or controlled, but rather as a Person that will lead us to the Heart of God. The Wild Goose series will help you experience a deeper relationship with the Person of the Holy Spirit, and as you come to experience God's presence and power this very same Spirit will transform you and bring you freedom.
