Guide to Format and Usage

Format

The Formation & Education Directory is organized:

- by the listing of the events by ministry;
- by the alphabetical listing of the events;
- by a calendar listing of the events.

The Archdiocese is committed to making all programs available for persons with disabilities. Please call the office contact *in advance* to ensure the availability of special services and/or equipment you will need to enhance your participation. Whenever possible, the Archdiocese will use locations accessible for persons using wheelchairs. Please check in the main parish section of the Catholic Directory for which sites are wheelchair-accessible, or call the contact person listed under the program you plan on attending.

Most events in the *Alphabetical Listing* section are coded with [CAT #<Task>]. This will be helpful for catechists and lay ecclesial ministers in tracking opportunities for professional development and continuing education. Washington State Clock Hours and Catechetical Renewal hours are determined by the length of the content provided within each event. Please refer to *The Whetstone* for Clergy Continuing Formation Units.

6 Tasks of Catechesis:

1. Knowledge of the Faith – resources, programs, activities, attendance, and practice of the faith
2. Liturgical Education – sacramental formation opportunities, reverence, understanding of the significance of liturgy
3. Moral Formation – quality of life within the parish or faith community, offering of service, evidence of conscience development
4. Teaching to Pray – practice of prayer, holiness, opportunities to experience and learn about prayer
5. Education for Community Life – degree/quality of life in the parish or faith community and beyond, leaders and servant roles
6. Missionary Initiation – learning and understanding the mission of Christ and the Church, demonstrating commitments at home and abroad

Usage

The formation and education events are designed for both leaders and staff. The definition of each is:

- Staff are paid and unpaid individuals who offer the services, programs, and activities within each parish or faith community.
- Leaders are usually unpaid individuals who serve on councils, commissions, boards, and whose influence guides the parish and/or Archdiocese.

Each event is designed for certain audiences. Please check the alphabetical listings for the primary audience for whom the program is intended.
