


# Driving Directions and Parking Information for the Mass

- Please follow the instructions provided here—they will assist with improving traffic flow entering the parking areas near the Marcus Pavilion on campus.
- The Knights of Columbus will be directing parking at Saint Martin's. They will be wearing **orange** KC vests. Please follow their directions.
- There is **very limited parking** for personal vehicles. As many people as possible should come by bus. If your parish does not provide a bus, try contacting other parishes in your area.
- All vehicles coming to the Mass should use **only** the Pacific Avenue entrance (5300 Pacific Ave SE) to the university. Please unload passengers only after your bus/vehicle is parked. To do otherwise will cause traffic problems.

# Saint Martin's University Parking




# From NORTH of Lacey

## Take I-5 South

-  Take Exit 111 for WA-510 E/Marvin Rd go .3 mi
-  Turn Left onto Marvin Rd NE go .5 mi
-  Turn right onto Martin Way E go 1.5 mi
-  Take left onto Carpenter Rd SE go .9 mi
-  Turn right onto Pacific Ave. SE go .3 mi
-  At the traffic circle, continue straight to stay on Pacific Ave. SE go .4 mi
-  Enter the Saint Martin's Campus on the right and follow the parking directors with orange vests.


# From SOUTH of Lacey

## Take I-5 North

-  Take Exit 108 towards Sleater-Kinney Rd / College St. go 0.2 mi
-  Take the Sleater-Kinney Rd. South - Exit 108A go 0.2 mi
-  Turn right onto Sleater-Kinney Rd SE go 0.4 mi
-  Turn left onto Pacific Ave. SE go 0.3 mi
-  Enter round about and take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto Lacey Blvd. SE go 0.7 mi
-  Turn left onto Franz St. SE go 0.2 mi

Enter the Saint Martin's Campus and follow the parking directors with orange vests.

-  Leaving Saint Martin's, turn right going west on Pacific Ave go 0.1 mi
-  Take the 1st left onto Ruddell Rd SE go 0.2 mi
-  Take the 1st left onto Lacey Blvd SE go 0.6 mi
-  Enter the roundabout and take the 4th exit onto Pacific Ave SE go 0.2 mi
-  Turn right onto Bowker St SE go 0.2 mi



This is the 36th annual march, marking the decriminalization of abortion in the landmark 1973 Supreme Court decision of Roe vs. Wade. As usual we will gather at the capitol steps in Olympia. Every elected state official is invited to attend, and we welcome legislators who stand with us for Life to speak to the crowd. We hope you will be there to hear their message for you!

We come together to advocate for the most vulnerable in our society. It is with hope that we fight for the rights to Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Happiness, for all.

Abortion laws in Washington are absurd and out of touch with the wants of the people of the state. There is no reason we cannot offer equal care to women and children (including the unborn) in our state and nationally. It is time to have an honest conversation about how we can find ways to protect children, support women, and build a society with a true respect for life.

Be a part of the conversation, and plan to make your voice heard with Washingtonians standing for Life in January. We encourage you to bring your group. And make a plan to visit your legislators.
